"Everyday Armor Part 4 – The Shield of Faith"

(Introduction)
Ephesians 6:16

"In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one."

The three central themes of the Bible:

- 1. God's love
- 2. Redemption through Jesus
- 3. Faith to live our lives for Him

Shield

- One type was a smaller oval shield that could be used in close combat to feign off the blows of a hand-held weapon
- The one Paul is writing of here is from the word "thureos" (Thoo-ray-ahz)
 - o 4'x2 ½' (slide 1)
 - Layers of woods covered with leather, soaked in water and bound with iron
 - o Large enough to cover the entire soldier
 - o Grouped together made a nearly impenetrable offensive weapon

Faith

- In the NIV faith is spoken of 270 times
- Eph 6:16 Paul says that with the armor take up the shield
 - o The armor is not meant to be used separately but combined
 - o Faith is the armor for the armor
- Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.
- What keeps the Christian today from using this definition every day?
 - Our intellect Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
 - o Unwillingness to completely give our lives to God I Tim 4:15

- Be diligent in these matters; give yourself wholly to them, so that everyone may see your progress.
- o Past hurts and disappointments Luke 16:15 Jesus is speaking to the Pharisees and reminds them that God knows the heart
 - Genesis 50:20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.
 - We do not know the full scope of God's plan in our situations
- Hebrews 11 is the "Faith Hall of Fame"
 - o 8 men who the author accounts their great faith
 - In detail for Abraham and Moses
 - The list includes Samson
 - A very flawed man
 - God does not require perfect people to accomplish His will
